"The Great Commission"

Matthew 28:16-20

Introduction

- A.** Do you remember the first time you heard the gospel and believed?
- B.** The gospel of Matthew ends with Jesus meeting with His apostles in Galilee. It was a meeting in which Jesus gave His disciples what is commonly called "**The Great Commission**".

I. All Authority (18)

- Jesus has been given all authority in heaven and earth.

II All Nations (19)

- "Go" is a command, not a suggestion.
- It is for "all nations". They were to go into all the world and preach the gospel to every person. The gospel is for **all**.

Making disciples by ...

- Baptizing them in the name of the Father, The Son and the Holy Spirit (19b).
- Teaching them to observe/obey **all** that Jesus commanded (20a)

III. All The Time (Always) With You (20b)

- If this mission seems like an impossible undertaking, Jesus says, "And behold I am with you always, even to the end of the age" or world.

IV. Application/Conclusion

- "The Great Commission" is a commission to the church today as well!
- Are we effectively reaching our neighbors/others?
- Are we effectively discipling those we reach?
- Are we seeing changed lives as a result of the gospel we proclaim?
