(Matthew 26:26-30; I Corinthians 11:23-29)

### Introduction

As we prepare to celebrate Resurrection Sunday in a few weeks, I will preach on the Lord's Supper this morning, and His triumphal entry to Jerusalem next Sunday.

### EASTER LILY EVENT

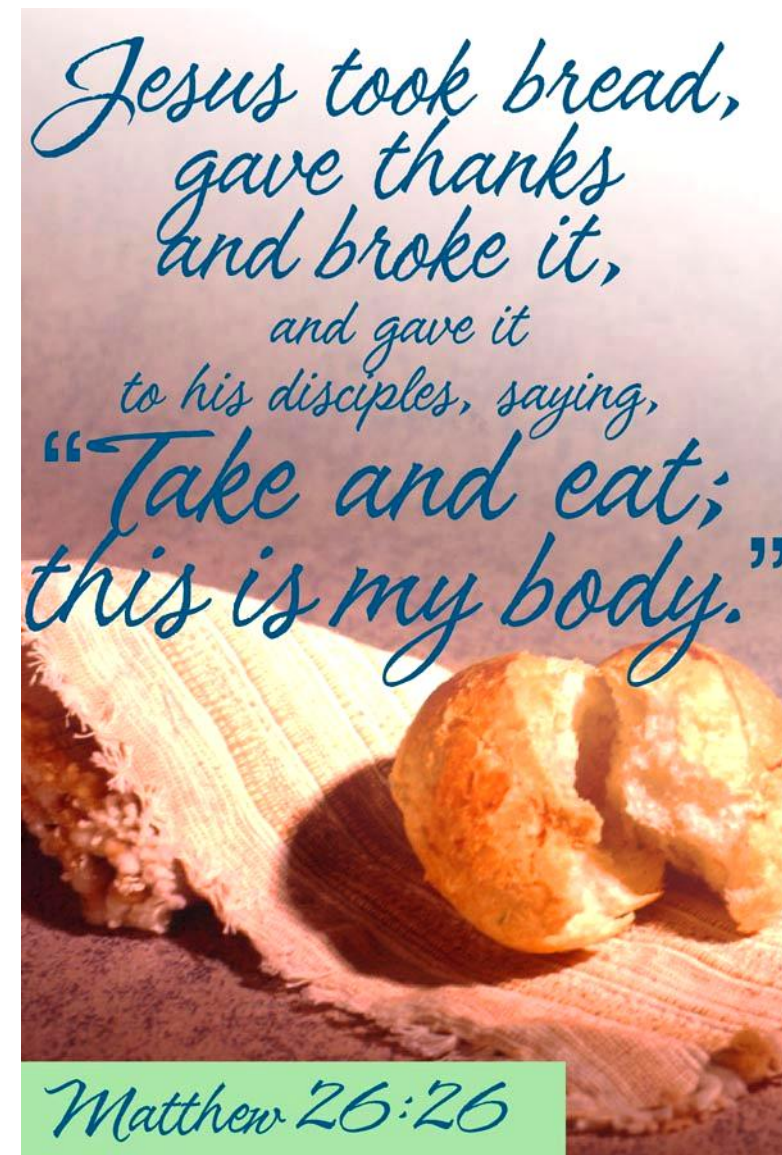
