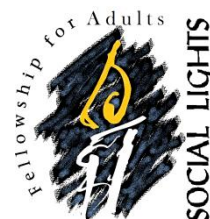


Have you picked up your 2019 offering envelopes?

SOCIAL LIGHTS

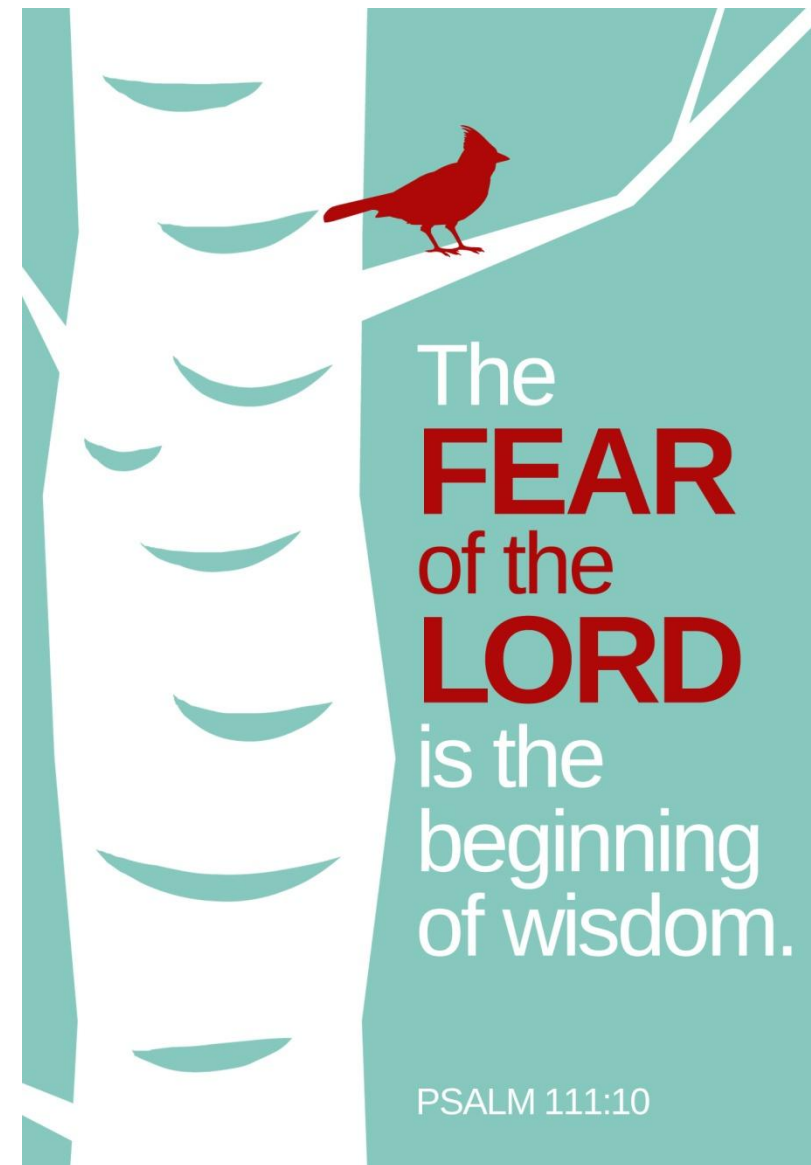
